- II. **Approval of Minutes / Action Items** 
  - The February 10, 2016 meeting minutes were reviewed for approval. No changes noted. The board approved by motion.

Motion (made by Commissioner Angenie McCleary and seconded by Frank Knight) "I move to approve the March 10, 2016 meeting minutes as written." Motion passed.

Optum Community Health Initiative (CHI) selection committee- Kate Wallace. Ms. Wallace presented to the board the request for volunteers for the CHI selection committee. They request one member of the BHB to volunteer in assisting in the review of the RFI's for Optum's CHI. Target is mid-April to have the volunteer group in place and hope to be doing final review of RFIs by September. After board discussion, it was agreed that John Inman would be the Region V volunteer; with Debbie Thomas as the alternate. The board approved by motion.

Motion (made by Frank Knight and seconded by Lee Wilson) "I move to approve the volunteer assignment of John Inman, with Debbie Thomas as the alternate, as the Region V BHB representative for Optum's CHI RFI review." Motion passed.

#### III. Non-Action Items

- A. <u>Board Orientation</u>- Steering Committee: Steering committee members oriented the board on the documentation and laws that govern the BHB. Each section was reviewed and discussed. Question were presented and answered by the appropriate committee member. There are 5 main topics: History of BHB; The Purpose of BHB; Bylaws and Appendix; Code of Ethics; and Navigation of Website and Dropbox.
- B: Behavioral Health Quick Care Center- John Hathaway: Mr. Hathaway presented to the board the legislative decision of the Mental Health Crisis Center (Quick Care). The monies were awarded to Region V in the amount of \$1.3 million. SCPHD will contract with IDHW as the fiduciary agent for management of the center. Mr. Hathoway thanked the board and Mr. LeBlanc for all the time and effort that has been put forth to make this a success. The next step is to convey the workgroup in order to proceed.
- C. <u>Mental Health Month</u>- Scott Rasumussen: Mr. Rasumussen presented to the board the events that will take place in May to promote Mental Health Month, So far there is a free screening scheduled for May 6<sup>th</sup>. The 5K Fun Run will be on May 7<sup>th</sup> at CSI Expo center followed by a Kids Fair right after the run. IDHW is scheduling other event and will send out more information as that happens.
