
- I. Safe House tour by Val Stotts – 10:15 a.m.

- II. Action Items – no quorum – all items moved to next month's agenda
- III. Non-Action/Announcements/Updates
 - a. Kevin advised that we need to do a reconciling of actual committee members. EJ & Kevin will have this accounting at next meeting.
 - b. Linda Montgomery (Board of Health chair) advised that the SCBHB must approve this subcommittee's minutes. Chris Freeburne volunteered to reach out to other Idaho regions to see how they are running their Children's Mental Health Subcommittees.
 - c. Skills Building – no update.
 - d. Y.E.S. Alyson – this program is starting its second year.
Independent assessor is still Steve Jennings. No change.
Kids from 1st year are renewing.
Region 5 numbers from the first year: 82 approved PCPs. Unknown how many did not qualify.

- e. Crisis Respite – Possibly funded as part of Y.E.S., but the rollout was pushed back. Kevin will look into this. Currently, with youth in crisis, law enforcement gets the call, then law enforcement refers to juvenile detention. Juvenile detention, however, is no longer accepting “status offense.” Kevin is looking into a place called Gus House in Boise. Compares to Safe House in Twin Falls. TF has no options for under age 18. Chris Freeburne from IDH&W will speak to us about the Families First Act at our next meeting.
- f. BH Services in Schools – Melody advised that Jerome School District asked the workgroup to attend a morning meeting. Melody and Kylie attended. Rachel Blanton from BCIF was on phone.


